Art and Photography Exhibition

Conditions of Entry:

1. Each artist is restricted to a maximum of 2 entries. No judge may submit entries.
2. Each work must have full details as stipulated on the entry form.
3. There will be no hanging fee but a commission of 40% will be charged, by the Byre theatre, on all works sold.
4. Pictures in the Art sections will not be hung unless they are properly framed. Provided with adequate and secure rings with masking tape to avoid scratching of other frames. We ask artists to pay very particular attention to these points, as they will be held responsible for damage or injury caused by failure to comply with these conditions.
5. Entries in the Photography sections may be in colour or black and white with a minimum size of 6" x 8", framed. Photographically and Digitally processed prints are equally acceptable.
6. The committee will not insure exhibits. Exhibitors may therefore wish to insure their own works.
7. All entries should not have been exhibited before in this exhibition.
8. The closing date for entries is Sunday 22nd November.
9. Ideally, the Byre would like to works to remain until 2 January 2010.
The Royal Burgh of St Andrews Community Council to have the later right to reproduce and exhibit all placed entries and others in the Photography sections we consider to be of the future social interest (these will be retained). This will not detract from the rights of the photographer. Photographers of retained prints are asked to supply brief details of themselves, location of scene etc. to be held with the print. The collection to be called The St Andrews Community Council Photographic collection. The collection to be retained on our behalf in the Preservation Trust Museum and will be available for future exhibitions or other purposes to the benefit of the citizens of St Andrews. The intention is to build a unique collection of photographers and their photographs.
10. There is a preview evening on day 25 November from 18:00-19:00. Light refreshments will be provided by the Community Council.
